



# Cyprus Senior Amateur Men's Open & Cyprus Senior Amateur Men's Open 2022



## ITINERARY

The Tournament Committee welcomes you to the 2022 Cyprus Senior Amateur Men's Open and the Cyprus Senior Amateur Ladies Open.

Below follows an outline of the timings etc. during the Tournament to assist you in planning your time.

### **Official Practice and Registration Day (Friday, 23 September)**

- The Official Registration Desk will be situated opposite the main entrance to the Secret Valley Resort Club House between 0830 and 1330. Any player who cannot register must still confirm his/her participation by calling +357 96 533813 not later than 1330 on Registration Day.
- The official draws for Saturday will be available at the Club and published on the CGF website ([www.cgf.org.cy](http://www.cgf.org.cy)) shortly after 1330 following the close of registration.
- Draws for Sunday will be available at the Club and will be posted on the CGF website within an hour of close of play of Day 1.

### **Competition Rounds (Saturday, 24 September and Sunday 25 September)**

For all competition rounds, practice facilities will be available prior to tee times. Please remember to arrive early each day to register and collect local rules. Scorecards will be collected from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee - except for those starting from Tee 10 on Day 2 who will collect their scorecards from the 10<sup>th</sup> tee.

- **Saturday, 24 September**  
First tee time will be at 0730 at 10-minute intervals. Lowest handicap players out first, with 50% of the men's field out first, followed by the ladies, then the rest of men.
- **Sunday, 25 September**  
2-tee start from 0800 at 10-minute intervals. Highest cumulative gross scores out first, in the same order (men/ladies/men) as on Day 1. Trailing 50% of players (men & ladies) off the 10<sup>th</sup>, the rest off the 1<sup>st</sup> – Leaders out last.  
There is a prize for a Hole-in-One on hole #10 for both men and ladies sponsored by Abbeygate Insurance – multiple winners share.

On all competition days, after your round you must check in at the Scoring Desk at the top of the outside stairs leading to the clubhouse, opposite the 18<sup>th</sup> green. **You must hand in your signed scorecards in the company of your playing partners for checking**, and to enable speedy resolution of any queries or issues. Cards submitted individually will **NOT** be accepted.

On the final day, you will be offered a voucher at the scoring desk for the presentation Buffet. The prize presentation will take place approximately 45 minutes after the close of play.

Please check the **Official Noticeboard** each day for any updates.

CGF has adopted "Ready Golf" in line with R&A recommendations, and pace of play will be monitored accordingly - see Noticeboard at Registration.

Volunteers will be present on the course – they will do their best to spot your ball but do try to assist them by signaling shots either right or left. A red flag means you should play a provisional ball. Referees will also be on course.

Live scoring will be in operation on both days, with scorers situated at the 5<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> tees. You are asked to assist the tasks of the Live Scoring scorers when asked.

Finally, the **Tournament Committee** hopes that you enjoy your time with us, and that you will take away positive memories.
