CONDITIONS

1. Format:

1.1 4-person team AMAM - Stableford off full handicap. Two scores to count on each hole.

2. Eligibility:

- 2.1 Open to male and female amateur golfers. Players may enter as a Team or individually - those entering individually will be amalgamated and formed into a Team.
- 2.2 All players other than CGF federated members must have a valid handicap certificate, issued by their home club not earlier than May 26, 2019.

3. Entries:

- 3.1 Entries must be submitted to the CGF through the electronic [Entry Form](#) found under the event's page on the CGF's website www.cgf.org.cy. All accepted Entries will be confirmed through email. Secret Valley members may, if they wish, enter their names in a special Entry List available at the Proshop.
- 3.2 All Entries shall be made by Wednesday, June 5, 2019.
- 3.3 The Entrance Fee is €40 for non-SVGR, and €15 for SVGR members.
- 3.4 Buggies and trollies are on a first come first served basis and must be booked and paid for directly with the club.
- 3.5 The club restaurant will make available to competitors a specially priced lunch.

4. Rules:

4.1 The Competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and in accordance with the Local Rules as approved by the Tournament Committee. Men play off the Yellow tees and Ladies off the Red tees, under EGA handicap rules. The relevant Handicap Table for each tee applies for conversion to playing handicap.

5. Decision of Ties:

5.1 In the event of a tie for the first, second or third places the winner will be decided on the lowest score for the last 9 holes, last 6, 3 or 1 hole.

6. Prizes:

6.1 Prizes will be awarded for First and Second place teams, Ladies Nearest to the Pin, and Ladies Nearest to the Line, Men's Nearest to the Pin, and Men's Nearest to the Line,

7. Starting Times:

7.1 The event will be a shotgun start at 08:30.

8. Pace of Play:

8.1 CGF, in line with strong recommendations from the R&A, has adopted 'Ready Golf' for all its events to improve pace of play. All players and teams must make every attempt to keep up with the group in front of them, with support and encouragement being given to anyone playing slowly.

9. Tournament Committee:

9.1 The Committee reserves the right to amend the above conditions, and to accept or refuse any entry without giving reason for its decision.
