Local Rules

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1)

Beyond any wall, fence, hedge or line of white stakes/fence bounding the course.

2. Water Hazards (Rule 26)

- a) Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes.
- b) Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes or redline.

3. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)

- a) All concrete/artificially surfaced paths and adjacent edges.
- b) Course furniture, including signs.
- c) Halfway House.
- d) Relief, without penalty, may also be obtained from an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole in play if it intervenes with the line of play between the ball and the hole provided that the ball lies off the putting green, not in a hazard, and within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction. The ball may be marked, lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point which a) is not nearer the hole b) avoids intervention c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

4. Movable Obstructions (Rule 24-1)

- a) Stones in bunkers.
- b) Rakes in bunkers.

5. Ground under repair (Rule 25.1)

Erosional damage in bunkers caused by running water washouts.

6. Integral Parts of the Course

All non artificially surfaced access roads and paths i.e gravel, stoned or hard core, including stoned garden areas beyond greens on hole 2, 3 and 11

7. Temporary Local Rules

Please check the notice board for any temporary Local Rules.

8. Etiquette

Please have regard for the wellbeing of fellow players and Greenkeeping staff with regard to safety.

9. Penalty for breach of Local Rules

Match Play – Loss of hole.
Stroke Play – Two strokes.

Slow Play

Slow play will not be tolerated. Any deliberate breach of slow play may result in the player being asked to leave the golf course.

Distances

Scorecard – Yards to the CENTRE of the green.
Sprinkler heads – Yards to the FRONT of the green.
