CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility

Amateur golfers of all nationalities, with a **Valid** WHS handicap within the limits as stipulated below (paragraph #3). Entry Application Forms <u>must</u> be submitted via the official electronic <u>Entry Form</u> found on the CGF's website, not later than <u>Wednesday</u>, 1 <u>June 2022</u>. Players may enter as a Team or individually - those entering individually will be amalgamated and formed into a Team. (Please indicate in the comments field of the Entry Application Form)

2. Form of Play

4-person team AMAM - Stableford off full handicap, played off the Yellow tees for men and Red tees for ladies. Two scores to count on each hole.

3. Handicap Limits

The maximum Exact WHS HI for entry is 36.0 for both men and ladies. Players other than CGF federated members must have a valid handicap certificate, issued by their home club not earlier than 23 May 2022. In the event of the event being oversubscribed, a waitlist will be created.

4. Fees

The Entry Fee is € 25.00 for all participants. Range balls are included in the price. The Club house restaurant will have a specially priced lunch on the day for those interested.

5. Caddies, Trolleys, and Buggies

Caddies are allowed but only competitors may ride in buggies should they wish. Buggies and trollies are on a first come first served basis and must be booked and paid for directly with the club.

6. COVID-19 Protocols

Competitors need to be in possession of SafePass and subject to any protocols in place at the time of the event as announced by CSO and the MoH. These include but not limited to wearing of a mask, time of arrival and leaving the course,

7. Registration and Starting Times

The Captain of each team and any caddies <u>must</u> report for Registration within the stipulated period of time as notified to all prior to the tournament. All players must be at the course at least 45 minutes prior to the **Shotgun start of 09:00**. This is to enable teams to reach their starting tees in time and to comply with the current COVID-19 Competition Protocol (if any) as approved by the Ministry of Health.

8. Trophies

Trophies will be awarded for First & Second placed teams, Ladies Nearest to the Pin, and Ladies Nearest to the Line, Men's Nearest to the Pin, and Men's Nearest to the Line.

9. Medical Care

Secret Valley GC has on-site staff trained as Medical First Responders, while a doctor will be on call at players' own cost

10. Tournament Committee

The Committee reserves the right to amend the conditions, and to accept or refuse any entry without giving reason for its decision.
