GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

Men players who conform to the current Amateur Status Rules of the R&A and hold a current and valid WHS HI. The maximum exact WHS HI for entry is 9.0. **At Registration, on Thursday, 22 May, entrants (other than CGF Federated players) must provide proof of current handicap certified on or after 19 May 2025.**

2. ENTRY APPLICATION AND FEES

- Applications for Entry must be made through the online Entry Application Form found on the CGF's website (<https://www.cgf.org.cy/reg/CAMO25entry>) no later than Monday, 19 May 2025. The closing date for Entry Applications may be changed and a Waitlist created at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. Should a Waitlist be created, preference will be given to international players and those with low handicaps.
- Entry fee is €195 (€155 for CGF Members and €60 for Eléa GC Full Members).
- The fee covers three competition rounds and one practice round (three competition rounds only for CGF Members), giveaways, prizes and a presentation buffet after close of play on the last day.

3. FORM OF PLAY

The tournament is a 54-hole stroke play World Amateur Golf Ranking (WAGR) event, handicap qualifying, using the Black tees, in accordance with the rules of golf as approved by the R&A, the Cyprus Golf Federation, and any Local Rules endorsed by the Tournament Committee.

4. TROPHIES

The player with the lowest gross score over 54 holes will be the **Cyprus Amateur Men's Open Champion 2025**. In the event of a tie, there will be a "sudden death" play-off over hole 18, repeated if required. For ties for all other prizes, countback procedures will apply. The Championship trophy will be retained in the offices of the Cyprus Golf Federation, while the Champion will receive a "keeper" trophy. Net trophies will be available, while on Day 3 a Hole-in-One prize will be available on a par 3 hole.

5. BUGGIES, CADDIES AND TROLLEYS

This is a walking competition, and no buggies may be used, except in the case of players with Official Registered Disabled status. Electric or manual trolleys may be used and if required must be pre-booked in advance directly with the club, subject to availability. Caddies are allowed but must register with the Registrar on a daily basis. For rules regarding caddies refer to the document [CGF Terms of Competitions](#) as published on the CGF's website.

6. LIVE SCORING

During play for all competition days, Live Scoring will be in operation, with scorers posted at predetermined places. Participants are required to cooperate with and assist the scorers in performing their duties.

7. REGISTRATION

Registration opens between 0830 and 1330 at Eléa GC on Thursday, 22 May, the official practice day. Any player unable to register must call +357 96533813 to confirm his registration. Furthermore, players are required to report to the Registration desk on a daily basis to collect their Scorecard for the day.

8. PRACTICE

International Players who wish to book a complimentary practice round on either Wednesday, 21 May **OR** Thursday, 22 May 2025, should make direct contact with the club (email: golfreservations@eleagolfclub.com | Tel: +357 26 202001). Additional practice rounds on previous days may also be booked direct at a preferential rate of €55

9. MEDICAL CARE

During play, a doctor will be on call at own expense.
